CASE STUDY ACTON MOBILE

INTRODUCTION

Acton Mobile (Acton) is a multi-regional provider of modular space rental services to the construction, commercial, industrial, education, healthcare, infrastructure, engineering and government markets.

They specialize in providing temporary building solutions for non-residential construction and business customers. Providing exceptional customer service and a superior customer experience are two of Acton's core values.

With a fleet of more than 10,000 units and a branch network of 38 regional service centers in 23 states, Acton offers rental, delivery, setup and maintenance services, pick up of temporary mobile office trailers, and the sale of both new and used units. From steel container office storage combination trailers to prefabricated mobile office trailers, Acton supplies its customers' needs on time and within budget.

BACKGROUND AND CHALLENGES

Acton had reached capacity on their existing desktop environment solution. The current setup used terminal services that provided users with the company applications. The servers were accessed with Windows desktops that were a burden to maintain.

Connecting to the servers was providing a less than desirable user experience. A server lockup would affect several users, and maintaining the servers along with the desktops was a great deal of work.

Acton was also looking to grow through acquisitions and needed to provide desktops to new employees quickly.

THE VISION

Acton needed a solution that:

- provides users with a responsive desktop and allows the company the flexibility to grow quickly.
- provides users with the feel of a personal desktop and the ability to access the resources and applications needed to stay productive.

Acton wanted to avoid:

- a solution in which one server is shared by many users with complicated access to local resources like scanners.
- to eliminate incompatibility issues when running applications in a Terminal Services environment.

THE SOLUTION: VBOX + ZERO CLIENTS

VBOX

After comparing options available in the marketplace, Acton selected Racktop Systems and its Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI) solution: vBOX.

The vBOX solution is designed specifically to meet Acton's challenges. vBOX addresses two of the top factors in a successful VDI implementation: the user experience and employee productivity. It also solves one of the most common engineering challenges by creating a user experience that is consistent with a dedicated desktop. The Racktop vBOX is a "converged architecture," designed to scale linearly with each appliance, delivering a optimal user experience level. As Acton grows, they can achieve that same user experience level at scale, simply by adding more appliances.

OTHER BENEFITS OF VBOX

Monitoring. With vBOX, Acton can now determine exactly what VDI users are doing, where they are browsing, and what they are accessing. Racktop has the ability to log both end user and administrator actions, end-user security events, logon/logoff, and website access. Logs can be forwarded to customer systems for permanent storage and analysis, or Racktop can store logs and provide a hosted analytical platform for remote access.

Security. vBOX also provides the most effective means to protect sensitive data. All user interactions with files occur within the virtual desktop environment without any linkage to external devices, and security issues such as data leakage and lost or stolen intellectual property are virtually eliminated.

ZERO CLIENTS

Acton executives realized that combining the Racktop vBOX with Racktop Zero Clients would be the fastest way to implement virtual desktops with the lowest risk and total cost of ownership.

The company needed to replace the Windows endpoints that were used to access the retired terminal servers. The Racktop Zero Clients were the perfect fit.

Zero Clients are directed at the escalating costs of managing traditional - and in this case aging - PCs. In addition to positive user experience and secure data, implementing the Racktop Zero Clients allowed Acton to lower the total cost of ownership (TCO). They require minimal maintenance, take less space, and use less energy than the desktop computers they replaced.
